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Communion Bread

1 Cup flour
1/3 Cup vegetable oil (scant)
1/8 teaspoon salt
1/3 Cup water

Preheat oven to 425 degrees. Line a baking sheet with parchment paper.

Mix flour, oil, and salt in a bowl; add water and mix using a pastry cutter until dough is soft. Form dough into 6 balls and press into disks onto the prepared baking sheet using your hands. Bake in the preheated oven until bread is cooked, 8 to 10 minutes.
