

Legacy of Scripture Instructions for Participants

The following are the steps to follow if you would like to participate in our Legacy of Scripture web page. If you have any questions, please contact Jeff McKune at jeff@mckune.net.

- Select a passage of scripture, not more than a chapter.
- Practice reading the passage aloud so that you are comfortable with the passage.
- The best sound quality will come from using a smartphone. If you do not have a smartphone, contact Jeff at the address above, and he will coordinate with you on a mutually convenient time to record.
 - *For all recordings, make sure you are in a quiet room, without other noises.*
Tip: A clothes closet is a good spot as the soft clothing prevents echo.
NOTE: Things that can cause problems with recordings include motors running in the background (A/C, refrigerator, or mower outside), a bangle bracelet (clicking noises), page turning, and echo from a large room.
 - For iPhone
 - Use the Voice Memos app that comes with the iPhone.
 - For Android phones
 - Use the Voice Recorder app or a similar app.
 - Record your passage as follows:
 - Tap to start a new recording.
 - Hold the microphone on the smartphone **to the side of your face** to avoid breath pops in the microphone as you read.
 - **If you must turn the page, first pause your speaking, turn the page, and then resume speaking.** We can easily edit out the page turning noise.
 - Wait 5 seconds before speaking.
 - State the passage you will be reading, and the Bible version you are using.
 - Read your passage.
 - Wait 5 seconds after speaking.
 - Tap to end the recording.
 - Feel free to re-record until you believe you have your best recording.

Please make sure that you only include the passage reference (book, chapter, and verses), version, and the passage. ***We ask that you do not include commentary or other thoughts.*** Please use one of the following major translations:

- American Standard Version
- Contemporary English Version
- English Standard Version
- King James Version
- New American Standard Bible
- New International Version
- New King James Version
- New Living Translation
- The Living Bible
